The truss rod tunes in how bent the neck is generally – this is called relief. When the strings are at pitch, put a capo on the first fret; this eliminates the nut's height from the measurement. Next, place your thumb on the 15th fret, which eliminates the bridge's height in the same way.

You will need a six inch ruler with 1/32" and 1/64" increment and a small phillips screw driver. First tune the guitar. Now measure the distance between the bottom of the string and the top of the 17th fret. Check with your guitar manufacture for the specifications for your particular guitar.

Guitar Setup and Intonation

Overview In Part 1 of the Guitar Setup Series, we adjusted the truss rod to set the neck relief. In Part 2, we will fine tune your string height so your guitar is perfectly tailored to your playing style. To do this, we will measure your guitar neck's action and adjust it for both Fender and Gibson-style bridges.

How To Setup Your Electric Guitar Part 2: Setting Action ...

Loosening the truss rod increases the curvature of the neck, tightening it makes the neck straighter. When set correctly, the neck should have a very slight concave curve to it, which our repairer measures by resting a long, metal straight-edge along the fretboard. Check for high frets.

Acoustic Guitar Set Up | A guide to the set up process

Pull the second and first strings 3 1/2" (89 mm) past their tuning posts and cut and wind as noted. For five-string basses, cut the fifth string 3" (76 mm) past its tuning post and repeat the same cutting and winding procedure. Vintage keys. Pre-cut each string for the proper length and desired amount of winds.

How do I set up my bass guitar properly? - Fender

Ok, there you have it: for a perfect setup of your guitar, you'll have to adjust the neck relief, the saddle height, and the slots in the string nut. Your goal, of course, is to get the smallest gap between any string and any fret without getting string buzz. Performing the setup is not very hard and requires only the most basic tools and skills.
